



What are the best restaurants in Vancouver?

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Vancouver's dining scene is vibrant, experimental and overflowing with culinary talent. Fresh, locally sourced ingredients, a heavy dose of West Coast influence and thoughtful menus satiate the heartiest appetites - and

the most curious palates. Fine dining is marked by a few heavyweights, including the 4-star rated **West** and perennial favourite **Bishop's**, also a Startle-rated restaurant. Newer to the scene, but no less noteworthy, is the impeccable **Hawksworth**. Every part of the Hawksworth dining experience is truly special, from the iridescent and modern space with custom artwork (pictured) to the expansive but approachable wine list and, finally, the incredible food, like the unabashedly popular Pacific sablefish with daikon.



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For a less formal (but no less delicious) experience, Vancouver is home to dozens of exciting and modern spots like **Chambar** (Belgian mussels and frites), **La Quercia** (a tiny neighbourhood spot serving up inventive Italian dishes), **L'Abattoir** (renowned for its fresh cocktails and innovate French cuisine with a West Coast influence) and of course, pizza. Neapolitan pizza has overtaken Vancouver's dining scene - and people can't seem to get enough of this traditional and artisanal cuisine; top spots to indulge include **Via Tevere** and **Nicli Antica Pizzeria**.
